Czech Republic has two priority countries in Africa – Angola and Zambia, but there are programs in other countries as well.

Bigger part of projects is realised by official support, part is financed only from private resources. Biggest project are in Ethiopia and Angola. Zambia is priority country but the support is very small. There was 14 projects running in 2005 with the budget 140 mil Kc (5 mil €). 8 projects is realised by one organisation for 106 mil. Kc, 6 projects by 4 organizations for 34 mil.

Coordination in your country on cooperation with Africa

We have in the Czech platform working groups on priority countries, as well as awareness raising, development education, sport and development and planning and strategy. Within the Zambian working group already three common projects were developed.

The working group on awareness raising is called common because is extended by organizations cooperating on Czech Against Poverty campaign. This is especially focused on MDGs, EU ACPs and Africa strategies.

Expectations/influence of EU-Africa strategy on future cooperation

New member states can be a problem in EU – Africa strategy, because most of these states are more oriented on Balkan and CIS countries. This is strong

Future plans for cooperation with Africa

There are no common concrete plans within the national platform instead of support MDGs and lobbying for relevant EU strategy in frame of international platforms.

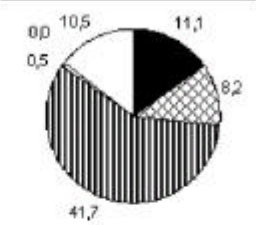

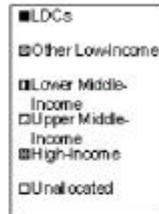

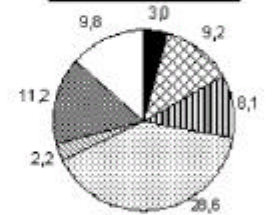
By Income Group (USD m)



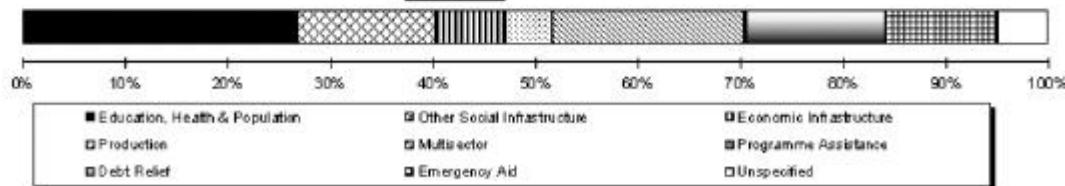
Clockwise from top
